## Internet Use Agreement

As a student, I want to use the devices and internet at St. Paul Lutheran Early Childhood Ministry. I know there are certain rules about what I should do online. I agree to follow these rules and my parents agree to help me follow these rules:

1. I will use devices at school only as my teacher instructs me.
2. I will stay on the website or app my teacher tells me to use.
3. I will not go onto Youtube, unless my teacher sets up something for me to watch.
4. My goal is to learn if I am using a device, not to do whatever I want to do.
5. I will only type in my name if my teacher says it's okay.
6. I will only take pictures of things that are a part of my learning.
7. I will not use something I found online and pretend it is mine.
8. I will not be sending or downloading inappropriate material.
9. If something strange or inappropriate comes on the screen, I will get my teacher right away.
10. Devices at school belong to the school.
11. I will practice the 10 commandments while using devices and the internet.
12. I understand that if I do not follow the rules, I may not be able to use devices at school.
